Who is eligible to receive the CATA Veteran pass?

Veterans from all U.S. Armed Forces and Reserves.

How much does the pass cost?

The pass is free to all Veterans with a valid ID.

Why would I want a CATA Veteran pass?

The CATA Veteran pass makes boarding quicker and easier! It is recognized by all CATA drivers and fareboxes so there's no need to carry any other form of ID. The pass is also easy to use.

Where can I get a CATA Veteran pass?

Passes are available at CATA's three facilities listed below. You'll need to present one of the valid forms of ID to receive a Veteran pass.

Where can I use the Veteran pass?

The pass is valid on all CATA services – Fixed-Route service, Spec-Tran, Redi-Ride, Connector, Shopping Bus, CATA Rural Service, Lot Link and Night Owl.

How do I use the Veteran pass?

Simply swipe your Veteran pass on any CATA farebox upon boarding. In some cases, show the driver your bus pass to obtain your free ride.

Is the Veteran pass the only way to get unlimited free rides year-round?

No. CATA also honors the following forms of ID in lieu of the Veteran pass:

- Valid U.S. Department of Defense ID
- Valid U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs ID
- Valid DD 214 form
- Valid driver's license or state ID with Veteran designation

How long is the Veteran pass good for?

CATA's Veteran pass is valid for up to 10 years. The expiration date is printed on the pass. Prior to the expiration, you'll want to obtain a new pass from one of CATA's three facilities listed below.

What if I lose my pass?

Replacement passes are available at CATA's three facilities listed below. You'll need to present one of the valid forms of identification to receive a new pass. Your lost pass will be deactivated immediately. Replacement passes are limited to one per person. There will be a \$5 charge for any additional replacement passes issued.
